Cedar, double blazed & scribed "1/4 S29 CS BT" bears N.59 1/2°W., 18.3 ft.</p> <p> 5" dia. Chinquapin, double blazed & scribed "1/4 S28 CS BT" bears N.48°E., 8.8 ft.</p> <p> 3" dia. D.Fir, double blazed and scribed "X BT" bears S.74°E., 15.6 ft.</p>	
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
