1/4 Corner for Secs. 31 and 32. (in Lane County)

Found - 1" iron pipe with a 2 1/2" brass cap attached established in 1926 by John G. Collins.

A 15" Hemlock snag with a single healed blaze bears S.87°W., 25.08

A 17" hemlock with a single healed blaze has been uprooted

Stumphole bears N.77°E., 3.96 ft.

Set - I placed a mound of stones around the iron pipe, and marked the Brass cap "T24S R2E".

New BT's- A 17" Cedar bears S.5°30'E., 74.9 ft. scribed "1/4 S32 BT" on double blaze.

A 8" Yew bears S.35°W., 69.2 ft. scribed "1/4 S31 BT" on double blaze.

Compass declination: 21°E. U.S.F.S. bearing tree signs were placed on all four BT's. This corner lies approx. 50 ft. south of F.S. Rd. No. 2425.
