Set post, 3 ft. long, & 3" sq., 24" in the ground for the ¼ sec. cor. marked ¼ S on W face, from which:
A cedar, 7" dia., bears S.84°E., 37 lks., mkd: ¼ S BT.
A hemlock, 9" dia., bears N.52°W., 26 lks., mkd: ¼ S BT.

Found - 6" Cedar snag, S.84°E., 24.4 ft., scribing visible.
7" Hemlock, snag on ground & 10' downhill from call distance, N.52°W., 17.2 ft.
Set from bearing & dist. of 6" Cedar snag:
16" Hemlock N.69°E., 63.4 ft., "W" nail & plate.
18" Cedar S.64½°E., 73.2 ft., "W" nail & plate.
