Set post, 3 ft. long, & 3" sq., 24" in the ground for the ¼ sec. cor. marked ¼ S on N face, from which:
A hemlock, 24" dia., bears N.52°W., 26 lks., mkd: ¼ S BT.
A vine maple, 4" dia., bears N.10°W., 7 lks., mkd: ¼ S BT.

Found - Orig. 24" now 40" hemlock alive, S.52°W., 17.2 ft., open & scribe visible.

New BTs- 9" Hemlock N.56°W., 69.9 ft., mkd: "¼ S 2 CS BT"

This corner lies on south edge of west end of new jeep road.

Found - A 1½" IP by DCSO in 1969 per CS file 54/27-160, firmly set 12" below the surface of an old jeep road, with a 2½" brass cap mkd

From which the original BTs rescribed by DCSO:
A 55" Hemlock bears S.47°45'W., 17.7 ft w/healed blaze (S.52°W., 17.2')

BTs BY DCSO:
A 24" Hemlock bears S.42°15'E., 45.4 ft. w/healed blaze (S.42°E , 45.0')

New BTs- A 5" W.Fir bears N.9°W., 19.3 ft. marked "X BT" on double blaze.
A 7" D.Fir bears N.35°E., 11.8 ft. marked "X BT" on double blaze.
