Set a post, 4 ft. long & 4" sq., 24" in the ground for the cor. to secs. 1, 2, 11, & 12, marked Tp. 24 S S1 on NE., R 2 W S12 on SE., S11 on SW & S2 on NW faces, with 5 notches on S & 1 notch on E edge, from which

- A fir, 24" dia. bears N.60°E., 42 lks. mkd: T24S R2W S1 BT
- A fir, 16" dia. bears S.31°E., 7 lks. mkd: T24S R2W S12 BT
- A pine, 6" dia. bears S.45°W. 12 lks. mkd: T24S R2W S13 BT
- A fir, 24" dia., bears N.18°30'W., 45 lks., mkd: T24S R2W S2 BT.

 - Orig. 6" Pine, down & blazed badly decayed S.45°W., 7.9 ft.
 - Orig. 24" now 28" Fir, alive, N.18½°W., 29.7 ft., very good scar.
