Found - 36" Hemlock S.55°W., 13, scribe/scar visible - orig. BT. (Appearance of BT: down across creek, pointing SW)
Corner location in reference to Terrain & cover: 1 chain East of creek bearing S.20°E., small opening 1 chain square. Hemlock & Cedar.

We find orig. BT as described in Forest appraisal notes - however we are unable to fix the exact location where it stood. Assuming it stood close to where it is now, the creek call would not fit by about 15 or 16 ft. No trace of OBT to north.
