Found - Oak, down & partly rotted, N.40°W., 82.5', cut open & fd. good scribing.
 Big stump hole, S.89°E., 248.8', no trace of stump left. (Both trees measured slope distance.)

Set - Brass cap at cor. mkd: COUNTY SURVEYORS OFFICE 1963
 T24S R4W WNW DLC 37
 8" D.Fir, N.72°W., 22.7', mkd: W NW DLC 37 CS BT.

 Corner lies approx. 65' west of centerline of Elkhead Rd.

Found - 2½" dia., brass cap (mkd: NNW not WNW) on a 1" I.D. x 32" long iron pipe. The monuments upper portion is bent SW'ly 1+ ft. and buried 6" below ground. An indistinct and shallow root-hole; bears S.89°E., 248.8 ft. as measured on the slope (agrees with 1963 rec.) Possible orig. BT.
 No evidence remains from other OBT or the 1963 renewal BTs; this area was cleared for pasture and a fir plantation several years ago.

New - The fd. monument still has a good plumb position below the bent portion; this position is referenced out and the monument is removed from the ground. The monument is mis-marked and is too severely bent to reuse, it is discarded.
 At the above described referenced position we set a new monument: A 2¾" dia., brass cap on a 1" I.D. x32" long iron pipe. Monument is set approx. 3" below ground. Cap mkd:

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New - An 18" dia., W.Oak scribed "WNW DLC37 CS" "BT" on a double blaze; bears N.40°E., 17.5 ft.
A 13" dia., D.Fir scribed "WNW DLC37 CS" "BT" on a double blaze; bears S.57¼°E., 23.7 ft.
A 13" dia., Oregon Ash scribed "WNW DLC37 CS" "BT" on a double blaze; bears S.17°W., 53.6 ft.
A 5" dia., D.Fir scribed "X" "CS BT" on a double blaze; bears N.23½°W., 68.0 ft.

Note - Monument is in small rolling pasture ground on a South East slope. Pasture is surrounded by medium age firs and oaks, and young plated firs. Sketch in file shows that monument is 70' west of the center line Elkhead Rd. Co. Rd. #50. Compass decl. 15½°E.
