A 17" dia., W.Oak scribed "NW DLC 38" "CSBT" on a double blaze; bears N.80½°W., 49.0 ft.

A white metal witness sign on a metal post is set West 1.0 ft.

Note - Corner monument is on gentle south slope in open oak woodland with old fir reprod to Northeast.
