S.51°E., 214.5 ft. is a good face measurement) OBT A 12" W.Oak, now a 13" dia., W.Oak with a fully healed double blaze; bears S.42°E., 11.3 ft. (as per rec.) 1963 An 18" W.Oak, now a 26" dia., W.Oak with a fully healed double blaze; bears S.14°W., 35.6 ft. (as per rec.) 1963</p> <p>New - An 18" dia., D.Fir scribed "INT L DLC 44 CS" "BT" on a double blaze; bears S.80½°E., 28.6 ft. A 16" dia., D.Fir scribed "NE DLC 45" "CS BT" on a double blaze; bears S.39°W., 10.3 ft.</p> <p>Note - B.C. monument is about 10 ft. east of a meandering, generally N-S running cat road and on a very gentle NW slope in an old second growth fir and oak woodland.
