Found - 2½" dia., brass cap (properly mkd) on a 1" I.D. iron pipe is bent and tilted 1.8 ft. northerly from plumb with its top buried approx. 4" below ground surface.
 Accessories are measured from plumb position of found monument.
 No evidence of OBTs fd in 1963 (pastureland has been since cleared)
 A 15" W.Oak, now an 18" dia., 3 ft. tall partly rotted W.Oak stump with evidence of a healed blaze is loose on ground surface and out of position. No evidence of root-hole is fd at record bearing and dist. 1963
 An 8" W.Oak now a 21" dia., W.Oak with a barely visible fully healed double blaze; bears N.46°E., 33.4 ft. (as per record) 1963

New - The plumb position of the fd BC monument is referenced out and the monument is removed; due to its condition this monument is discarded.
 At the above noted referenced position is set a 2¾" brass cap on a 1" I.D. 32" long iron pipe. The monument now protrudes 3" above ground.

A 19" dia., Oregon Ash scribed "NW DLC 45" "CSBT" on a double blaze; bears N.37½°W., 90.8 ft.
Note - Monument is in low flat drainage in cow pasture with scattered oak and ash.
Compass decl. 15½°E.
