The NE cor. of Claim No. 46, in Sec. 15, determined at record bearing and distance from the remains of the original NE BT:
A sawed Madrone stump, 34" dia., bears N.70°E., 23 lks., with rotted double blaze and partial scribe marks visible in reverse on remains of tree lying downhill to the SE.

A Fir, 10" dia., bears S.27°E., 81 lks., w/healed blaze.
A sawed Fir stump, 22" dia., bears S.72°W., 25 lks., w/scribe marks DLC No. 46 BT visible on open blaze.
and new bearing tree
A Fir, 8" dia., bears S.53°W., 36 lks., mkd: C 46 BT.

The NE. cor. of DLC No. 46, monumented with an iron post, 2½" dia., firmly set, projecting 3" above ground, with brass cap (properly) mkd.
from which the remains of an original bearing tree
A sawed, decayed madrone stump, 27" dia., bears N.70°E., 15.2 ft., with a hollowed blaze.
and the remains of BTs mkd. by White and McDonald in 1963
A fir, 27" dia., bears S.27°E., 53.5 ft., with a healed blaze.
A sawed, decayed fir stump, bears S.72°W., 16.5 ft., with no marks visible.
and a bearing tree mkd. by Jelly in 1979
A fir, 13" dia., bears S.53°W., 23.0 ft., with a healed blaze. (Record, 23.8 ft.)
Corner is located 74 ft. E. of a ridge, bears N.35°W. and S.25°E.
