A North and South fence line runs 2 feet west of corner.</p>

An Oak, 15" dia., now a 17" dia., 3 ft. tall rotted oak stump with a previously opened blaze (previously fd scribing now rotted away); bears N.50°E., 21.4 ft. (Rec. N.50°E., 20.5 ft. possible face meas.) OBT No evidence of SW OBT remains A 6" W.Oak, now a 9" dia., W.Oak with a fully healed double blaze; bears S.77°W., 5.5 ft. (rec. S.77°W., 5.8') 1963 A 7" W.Oak, now an 8" dia., W.Oak with a fully healed double blaze; bears N.20°W., 25.0 ft. (rec. N.20°w., 24.7') 1963 A N-S fence line is 2 ft west of corner monument.</p> <p>New - The highest point on the easterly edge of a 4½x3x2 ft. tall boulder bears N.25¾°E., 82.7 ft. An 8" dia., madrone scribed "NE DLC 47 CS" "BT" on a double blaze; bears N.61°E., 26.6 ft.</p> <p>Note - Monument is on gentle south slope in an Oak woodland with scattered madrone, fir, and cedar. Compass decl. 15¼°E.</p>
