An old iron gate hinge, as described in 1963 renewal, is fd flush with ground on North edge of BC monument. Fence corner with fences running North, South, and East is North 10 ft. from BC (rec. North 9.5 ft.) The two OBTs fd in 1963 now fall in a vineyard clearing and no evidence. An 18" W.Oak, now a 31" dia., W.Oak with a fully healed single blaze; bears N.89°E., 245.7 ft. (as per record) 1963</p> <p>New - A 17" dia., D.Fir scribed "SW DLC 47 CS" "BT" on a double blaze; bears S.65½°E., 82.5 ft. A double-trunk W.Oak (growing against an E-W fence) the southerly 10" dia., trunk of which is scribed "CSBT" on a high blaze (4½ above grown). The CRC of this tree bears N.41°E., 13.0 ft.
CRC = center root collar

Note - Monument is near top of broad East-West running ridge, vineyard to West.
Brush overgrown pasture in NE quadrant.
Fir, Pine and Oak woods in SE quadrant.
Compass decl. 15¼°E.
