PRIMARY CORNER DESCRIPTION 1/4 Cor. Secs. 11 & 14

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Original - Oscar F. Thiel, Contract #658, May 1896 (DCSO records Vol. 7 Page(s) 3065)

Set a sandstone 15x8x6 ins. 10" in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor. mkd. 1/4 on N face from which

A Cedar, 18" dia., bears S.9°W., 57 lks., mkd: 1/4 S BT.

A Cedar, 20" dia., bears N.30°E., 38 lks., mkd: 1/4 S BT.

This corner is 275' above creek.

Found - Rock set by Thiel, mkd: "1/4S on N face.

24" I.Cedar, S.9°W., 37.6', shows 2 very plain axe scars.

Badly burned Cedar snag, N.30°E., 25.1', no mks. left on snag.

Set - Brass cap, alongside rock, at cor. mkd: COUNTY SURVEYORS OFFICE 1963 T24S R4W 1/4 S11/S14.

12" D.Fir, N.61°E., 26.0', mkd: 1/4 S11 CS BT.

Corner lies on bench at edge of marshy ground, just E. of top of ridge.
