mkd w/portions of a rotted blaze. (Rec. dist 1216 lks.)  
and bearing trees not of record:  
A W.Oak, 7" dia., bears S.34½°E., 23 lks., mkd with a  
rotted blaze and partial scribe mks.  
A W.Oak, 10" dia., bears S.45°W., 28 lks. with a healed  
blaze facing the corner.  
A W.Oak, 11" dia., bears N.36 3/4°W, 57 lks. mkd S23 on  
an open blaze.

At the corner point  
Set an iron post, 28" long, 2½" dia., 22" in the ground, with  
brass cap mkd: T 24 S R 4 W
