I find depression which may have been location of orig. SW BT. Record calls for two BTs to NW. I believe it should read S.75°W., 216.5 ft.

48" W.Oak checks orig. bearing for NE BT, dist. 441.0 ft., shows old axe work, center rotted, no scribing found.
