Set Cedar post 4 ft. long, 4" sq., 24" in the ground for ¼ sec. cor. mkd. ¼ S on N. face, from which
 A Fir 30" dia., bears S.26°30'E., 57 lks. mkd. ¼ S BT.
 A Laurel 6" dia., bears N.43°30'E., 26½ lks. mkd. ¼ S BT

Survey by Bert W. Udell - Wit: H.E. Taylor - Sept. 3-4, 1948 C.S. File 40/114

Ascertained this corner by chopping out the stump of the 30" Fir, as recorded in the govt. notes. Found the scribe "¼ S". Measured N.26½°W., 37.62 ft. and then N.43½°E., 17.5 ft. Found at this point, an 8" Madrone. This appeared to be a shoot from the original tree, remains of which were on the East side of the shoot.
 Set stake at the corner and mkd. new trees:
 18" W.Fir S.80°E., 9.5 ft.
 36" W.Fir N.18°W., 32.0 ft.

Found - Stake set by Udell in 1948, rotted off but stake and rotted point in ground and still there.
 W.Fir now 22", S.80°E., 9.5 ft. with scribe showing in center of scars which have not completely grown together.
 36" W.Fir, down and dead, N.18°W., 32 ft. Did not find scribing. Log partially buried in dirt.
 Fir stump now 40", S.26°30'E., 37.6 ft. scribed "¼S" still showing, characteristics of Whipple's scribing.
 Laurel stump N.43°30'E., 17.5 ft., no scribing. All of orig. tree probably gone.

Found - 2½" brass cap on 1" iron pipe, 1.15 ft. above grade. W.Fir 33" (22") dia., bears S.80°E., 9.5 ft., with visible "X" chop at eye level & healed face. Root hole & partial root wad (36" dia., W.Fir) bears N.18°W., 32 ft. Fir stump 40" dia., bears S.26°30'E., 37.6 ft. with visible scribing & tag. 27" (22") D.Fir bears N.74°W., 47.6 ft., with healed face.

New BTs- Grand fir 15" bears S.31°W., 39.4 ft., face scribed "N¼ S8 BT", tagged & painted. Grand fir 16" bears N.12°E., 27.6 ft., face scribed "S¼ S5 BT", tagged & painted.

Note - Distances to fd. BTs were measured with EDM at approx. side center of root crown. New BTs were measured to a spike set at approx. side center. Trees were red band & face painted. Trees fd. with out tags have new tags facing monument.
