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Found - ¾" BLM brass cap (properly mkd), 0.4' above ground from which:  
A 42" Cedar bears N.41½°E., 102.7' w/ith healed blaze (1973)  
Established the following -  
A 21" Cedar bears S 61°E., 7.4' mkd: ¼ S14 BT.  
(Set chaining nail at side center, BT signs on front and back and painted red band for existing & new BTs)
