Found - A 3¼" dia., brass cap (properly mkd) on a 2" I.D. iron pipe is set plumb protruding 1" above ground. 1975-76
A G.Fir 6" dia., (mis-identified species) now a 16" dia., D.Fir with a fully healed double blaze; bears S.24°W., 21.4 ft. (as per rec.) 1976
A Fir 8" dia., now a 17" dia., D.Fir with a fully healed double blaze; bears N.58½°W., 16.2 ft. (as per record)
New - A 14" dia. D.Fir scribed "C¼ S17 CS" "BT" on a double blaze; bears N.58½°E., 18.9 ft.
A 13" dia. D.fir scribed "C¼ S17" "CSBT" on a double blaze; bears S.34°E., 13.0 ft.
Note - Monument is on moderately steep SE'ly slope in an old reprod. fir forest. From the intersection of Basin Creek Rd. and a private Rd. go N.16°E., approx. 145 ft. along private Rd. then West approx. 28 ft. from centerline to C¼.
Compass decl. 15½°E.
