1980 2½" dia., brass cap (properly mkd) on a 1½"
I.D. iron pipe set plumb, protruding 7" above
ground.
1976 BT- A 32" fir now a rotted 30" dia., 1½ ft. tall fir
stump with no blaze evidence remaining; bears
S.8°E., 41.9 ft. (rec. S.12°E., 41.9 ft.)
The SW BT position now falls in a skid road; no
evidence remains.
1980 BT- A 20" W.Fir now a 33" dia., Grand Fir with a fully
healed double blaze; bears N.88°W., 20.8 ft. (as
per record)
New - A 16" dia. Grand Fir scribed "¼ S4 CS" "BT" on a
double blaze; bears S.52½°E., 9.8 ft.
A 14" dia. D.Fir scribed "¼ S4 CS" "BT" on a double
blaze; bears S.3°E., 20.4 ft.
A 10" dia. D.Fir scribed "¼ S4 CS" "BT" on a double
blaze; bears S.38¾°W., 38.7 ft.
Note - Monument is in old growth mixed fir forest with 30+
year old fir reprod. to south. Monument is on
gentle west slope.
Compass decl. 15½°E.
