A hemlock 30" dia., now a 34" dia., hemlock with a fully healed blaze; bears N.73°E., 50.8 ft. (as per record)
Letters scribed in rock bluff "X BO" actually marked "B X O" (2" letters and a 3x3" X) the center of which bears S.34½°W., 13.2 ft. (as per record)

A metal phone pedestal marked "#7"; bears N.36°E., 48.1 ft.

A metal milepost marked "8 DOUGLAS COUNTY 57" on the westerly rd shoulder; bears N.13½°W., 42.7 ft.

A 22" Myrtle scribed "WC CS BT" on a single blaze; bears N.3°W., 143.3 ft.

Note - Monument is in solid rock shelf just above westerly road shoulder.

Compass decl. 15½°E.
