Set ¼ sec. post, from which
A Fir 24" dia., bears S.25°E., 20 lks. dist.
A Fir 36" dia., bears S.10°W., 15 lks. dist.

Douglas Co. Surveyors Office - James Byron, Deputy - Milo Godfrey; S. Bilow, crew - April 17, 1958 - C.S. File 49/41-7

Found - Orig. Fir, snag, now 29" dia. S.25°E., 13.2 ft.
Orig. Fir tree, alive, now 45" dia., S.10°W., 9.9 ft. Bark blaze and rescribe in bark "¼ S2 CS".
New BT - Bark scribe "¼ S1 CS" and blaze and scribe in wood "BT" on 44" D.Fir which bears N.80°E., 22.3 ft.
At corner, Set Iron pipe with brass cap stamped: "County Surveyors Office 1958 T24S R7W ¼ S2|S1".

BLM resurvey by Joseph S. Gawron, Cadastral Surveyor, under Group #405, surveyed June 1958 - (DCSO records Vol. 30 Page(s) 12588-89)

The ¼ sec. cor., monumented with an iron post, firmly set, protruding 6" above ground with brass cap mkd. by the County in 1958,
from which the original bearing trees
A Fir 32" dia., bears S.25°E., 20 lks. dist. mkd. ¼ on exposed face.
A Fir 44" dia., bears S.10°W., 15 lks. dist. with healed blaze.

At the corner point
Set an iron post, 30" long, 2" dia., 22" in the ground, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd:

A Fir 10" dia., bears N.20°E., 73 lks. dist. mkd. ¼ S1 BT
A Fir 14" dia., bears N.3½°W., 67 lks. dist. mkd. ¼ S2 BT
Reset County Surveyors post alongside the iron post.

From the 1958 BLM Survey
Found - A 3¼" dia., brass cap (properly mkd) on a 2" I.D. IP is set plumb & protruding 2" above a rough mound of stone which is now mostly covered by soil.

From the 1958 renewal
Found - A 2½" dia., brass cap (properly mkd) on a 1" I.D. Iron pipe is set plumb and protruding 6" above the mound of stone. This monument is set on the north edge of the BLM monument.

Accessories are measured from the BLM monument.
2 OBTs - A fir 24" dia., now a rotted and broken 17" dia., 8 ft. tall fir snag with an open rotted blaze showing a possible scribed "BT"; bears S.25°E., 11.2 ft. (rec. S.25°E., 13.2 ft. is possibly a slope measurement to center of trunk)

A fir 36" dia., now a shattered and rotted 55" dia., 6 ft. tall fir stump with no remaining blaze evidence; bears S.10°W., 9.9 ft. (as per rec.)

1958 DCSO renewal -
A 44" dia., D.Fir now a 54" dia., D.Fir with a fully healed single blaze and a bark blaze no longer showing scribing; bears N.76°E., 22.3 ft. (rec. N.80°E., 22.3 ft.) This tree also has a BT tag of unknown origin, showing the 1958 bearing and dist. dated 2/13/03

1958 BLM renewal -
A fir 10" dia., now a 21" dia., D.Fir with a fully healed double blaze & a single bark blaze scribed "¼ S1 BT"; bears N.20°E., 48.2 ft. (as per rec.)
A fir 14" dia., now a 23" dia., D.Fir with a fully healed double blaze & a single bark blaze scribed "¼ S2 BT"; bears N.3½°W., 44.2 ft. (as per rec.)

BT of Unknown origin (w/BT tag dated 2/13/03) -
A 17" dia., D.Fir with a fully healed double blaze and a single bark blaze showing now illegible scribing; bears S.24°W., 50.1 ft. (Fd. BT tag indicates a measurement of S.24°W., 51.0 ft.)

New - All accessories are flagged and are tagged with tags showing measurements from this renewal.

Note - Monument is on moderate SE slope approx. 40 ft. above draw bottom. Monument is in fir and maple forest with old reprod to the south and old growth to the north.
Compass decl. 15½°E.
