A Fir 60" dia., bears S.50°E., 81 lks. dist.

A Myrtle 12" dia., bears N.75°E., 27 lks. dist.

The cor. tree and one of the bearing trees being gone, I re-establish the cor. as follows:

Set a stone 14x10x8 ins., 10" in the ground for meander cor. to fractional secs. 13 and 24, marked M C on W. face, from which

A Fir 70" dia., bears S.50°E., 81 lks. dist. mkd. T24S R7W S24 MC BT.

An Alder 10" dia., bears N.82°E., 21 lks. dist. mkd. T24S R7W S13 MC BT.
