

PRIMARY CORNER DESCRIPTION So. 1/4 cor. for Sec. 32 only, T23-8

Alias	Description
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GLO survey by William R. Whipple, Deputy Surveyor, under Contract #622, dated June 23, 1893 (DCSO records Vol. 6 Page(s) 2556)

Set a post 3 ft. long, and 3" sq., 2 ft. in the ground for ¼ sec. corner marked ¼ S on N. face, from which

- A Hemlock 36" dia., bears N.29°W., 17 lks. mkd. ¼ S BT.
- A Hemlock 6" dia., bears S.37°E., 30 lks. mkd. ¼ S BT.

Remonumentation of corner by Joseph Gawron, Cadastral Surveyor, under Group # (?) Surveyed 1963 - DCSO records, Vol. 33 Page #'s 13871-72)

The ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 32 only, monumented with an alum. pipe ½" dia., firmly set, protruding 8" above ground, from which the original bearing tree:

A down Hemlock 60" dia., bears N.29°W., 17 lks. dist., with a healed blaze.

A down Hemlock 10" dia., bears S.37°E., 30 lks. dist. with partial scribe marks visible on opened blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28" long, 2 1/2" dia., 24" in the ground, with brass cap mkd:

T 23 S R 8 W
 S 32
¼ T 24 S
 1963

from which

A Hemlock 40" dia., bears N.36°E., 78 lks. dist. mkd. ¼ S32 BT.

A Hemlock 6" dia., bears N.53½°W., 123 lks. dist. mkd. ¼ S32 BT.

Reset the alum. pipe alongside the iron post.

Found - 1963 Cadastral brass cap, properly mkd. and 1/2" I.P. alongside.

Orig. 60" Hemlock now turned out stump, nearly face down, N.29°W., 11.2 ft.

1963 40" Hemlock, alive, face burned, N.36°W., 51.5 ft. (Rescribe "¼ S32 CS BT")

1963 6" Hemlock, down and dead, face burned, N.53½°W., 81.2 ft.

New BT - 5" Hemlock N.36°W., 41.5 ft. mkd. ¼ S32 CS BT.

Corner lies approx. 150 ft. West of small creek, course N.

ft. to "W" nail.
48" Fir stump, WEYCO tag & nail bears S.56°W., 25.1
ft. to "W" nail.
16" Fir, WEYCO tag & nail bears N.16°W., 19.0 ft. to
"W" nail.
New - 15" Fir, scribed "S32 ¼ BT" bears S.80°E., 11.5 ft.
to spike.
