

PRIMARY CORNER DESCRIPTION CC Secs. 8 & 9 (North)

Alias	Description
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GLO retracement by Levi C. Walker, Deputy Surveyor, under special instructions, dated Aug. 23, 1905, independent of but in connection with his contract # 763, dated June 20, 1905 - (DCSO records Vol. 8 Page(s) 3454)

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Set a hemlock post, 3 ft. long, 5" sq., 24" in the ground, for CC of Secs. 8 & 9, marked CC T 24 S R 9 W on S., S9 on E & S8 on W face, with 5 grooves on S & 4 grooves on E face, from which

- A fir, 36" dia., bears S.29°E., 120 lks., mkd: T24S R9W S9 BT.
- A fir, 48" dia., bears S.77°W., 29 lks., mkd: T24S R9W S8 BT.

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Found - 3/4" iron pipe (1956 Weyerhaeuser records indicate that 2 original GLO BTs were found, a 3" iron pipe was set at that time.) from which

- 48" fir stump, possible face, Weyco tag, bears: S.77°W., 19.1 ft to center. (GLO: 48" fir, S.77°W., 29 lks)

New BTs-

- 18" fir, Weyco tag & spike, bears: N.54°E., 4.4 ft to spike.
- 12" fir, Weyco tag & spike, bears: S.07°W., 14.1 ft to spike.
- 11" fir, Weyco tag & spike, bears: N.41°W., 12.6 ft to spike.
