A Fir, 24" dia. bears N.74°E., 33 lks. mkd T25S R1W S27 BT
An Arbutus, 6" dia., bears S.55°E., 46 lks. mkd T25S R1W S34 BT
A point of rock bears S.65°W., 39 lks. mkd + B0.
An arbutus, 6" dia., bears N.34°W., 52 lks., mkd: T25S R1W S28 BT.

Found - Marks on bed rock as follows: ± |||
A 17" fir snag bears N.74°E., scribing visible on partly burned blaze. "T 2 S R S 2 BT"
A rock point bears S.65°W., 19.1 ft. (rec. 25.7 ft.)
No marks visible.
Bearing trees to the NW & SE are gone.
New - A point of rock bears S.65½°W., 20.4 ft. mkd "X B0"
I chiseled the existing marks on the bed rock so they show better.
12" D.Fir bears S.87°E., 90.0 ft. scribed "T25S R1W S34 CS BT" on a double blaze.
16" D.Fir bears N.36°E., 24.3 ft. scribed "T25S R1W S27 CS BT" on a double blaze.
11" D.Fir bears N.29°30'W., 37.1 ft. scribed "T25S R1W S28 CS BT"
Placed BT signs on all trees.
Corner lies approx. 1000 ft. south of end of new US Plywood road.
