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A Dogwood, 5" dia., for 1/4 sec. cor., I mark 1/4 S3 on N & S10 on S sides, from which  
A chinquapin, 5" dia., bears S.20°W., 8 lks. mkd: 1/4 S10 BT  
A fir, 6" dia., bears N.21°E., 22 lks., mkd: 1/4 S3 BT.

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Set - 2 1/2" dia., alum cap.  
6" D.Fir S.33 1/2°W., 30.2 ft.  
40" D.Fir stump N.36°E., 52.1 ft.

BLM Dependent resurvey by Wayne Rogers, Cadastral Surveyor, under Group #1347, surveyed Sept 1986/April 1987 - (DCSO records Vol. 49 Page(s) 18421)

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Point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 3 & 10, at proportionate dist; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Set a stainless steel post, 28" long, 2 1/2" dia., 24" in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 4" dia., bears S.4°E., 23 lks., mkd. 1/4 S10 BT.  
A fir, 4" dia., bears North, 40 1/2 lks., mkd. 1/4 S3 BT.  
Deposit a white "DEEP-1" magnetic marker at the base of the stainless steel post.  
From this point, a point established & recorded as the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 3 & 10, by Shrum, in 1966, bears S.84°25'00"W., 0.380 chs., monumented with an iron post, 1" dia., firmly set, projecting 4" above ground, with a 2" dia. aluminum cap mkd. TWP 25S R1W 1/4 3 10 RE 4287, from which the remains of bearing trees mkd. by Shrum:  
A sawed fir stump, 60" dia., bears N.33°E., 78 lks., with scribe marks S3 BT visible on open blaze.  
A fir stump, 9" dia., bears S.32°W., 45 lks., no marks visible.  
This position was established using improper control; therefore is not used in this resurvey.
