A root hole, bears N.48°E., 56 lks., with a down fir alongside, 20" dia., with healed double blaze.
A root hole, bears S.85°E., 30 lks., with a down hemlock alongside, 19" dia., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on partially healed, double blaze.
A fir, 15" dia., bears S.15°W., 44 lks., with healed, double blaze.
and new bearing trees
A hemlock, 5" dia., bears N.61½°E., 57 lks., mkd. T25S R1W S2 BT.
A fir, 21" dia., bears S.68½°E., 93 lks., mkd. T25S R1W S11 BT.
A hemlock, 3" dia., bears N.45°W., 21½ lks., mkd. X BT.
From this corner, a control point at latitude 43°25'21.81"N & longitude 122°47'01.66"W established in conjunction with this survey, bears N.79°09'42"W., 10.530 chs., monumented with a finned aluminum rod, 36" long, 3/4" dia. firmly set 36" in the ground, in a collar of concrete, with aluminum cap, 2½ ins. dia., mkd. ECI G 1347 1987.

Found - A 1½" Iron post by DCSO in 1962 per CS 52/30, firmly set and projecting 10" above the ground, with original stone against north side, with a 2 1/2" DCSO brass cap (properly) marked

A 22" D.Fir bears S.14°15'W., 28.6 ft w/healed double blaze (S.15°W., 44 lks)
And BTs by Rogers in 1986/1987, BLM GROUP #1347 -
A 14" Hemlock bears N.58°00'E , 37.4 ft w/healed blaze (N.61½°E., 57 lks)
A 24" D.Fir bears S.71°30E., 60.7 ft w/healed blaze (S.68½°E., 93 LKS)
A 12" Hemlock bears N.47°45'W., 14.3 ft w/healed and and low blaze (N.45°W., 21.5 lks)
