

PRIMARY CORNER DESCRIPTION 1/4 Cor. Secs. 5 & 6

Alias	Description
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GLO Survey by Hezikiah H. Johnson, under Contract #721, dated May 1, 1900 (DCSO records Vol. 9 Page(s) 3655)

Set basalt stone 24x6x6", 18" in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor. marked 1/4 on W face, from which

- A cedar, 30" dia., bears N.68°E., 40 lks., mkd: 1/4 S5 BT.
- A cedar, 14" dia., bears N.60°W., 37 lks., mkd: 1/4 S6 BT.

BLM dependent resurvey Levi E Tallett, Cadastral Engineer (1951) and C. Albert White, Cadastral Surveyor (1963), under Group # 294, surveyed May 1951 - Aug 1963 - (DCSO records Vol. 32 Page(s) 13356)

The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 5 & 6, monumented with a basalt stone, 20x8x7", firmly set, marked 1/4 on W face, from which the original bearing trees:

- A cedar, 36" dia., bears N.79 1/2°E., 41 lks., blaze rotted. (Rec: bears N.68°E., 40 lks.)
- A cedar, 20" dia., bears N.50°45'W., 37 lks., scribe marks 1/4 6 BT visible. (Record bearing N.60°W.)

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 36" long, 1" dia., 28" in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A hemlock, 10" dia., bears S.33 1/4°E., 23 lks., mkd. S5 BT.
Bury the original corner stone alongside the iron post.

Found - Brass cap

- 42" dia., cedar w/rotted blaze bears N.79 1/2°E., 27.1 ft
- 33" dia., cedar w/healed blaze bears N.50 3/4°W., 24.4 ft

Set - 6 ft. steel post 2 ft. N.15°28'E.

BLM Dependent resurvey by Richard J. Dieckmann, Cadastral Surveyor, under Group No. 2749, surveyed Aug. 2014/April 2015 - (DCSO records Vol. 58 Page(s) 23346)

The 1/4 sec cor. of secs. 5 and 6, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set, projecting 8 ins. above the ground, with a brass cap (properly) mkd.
from which the original bearing trees

- A red cedar, 44" dia., bears N.79 1/2°E., 27.1 ft., with a decayed healed blaze.
- A red cedar, 28" dia., bears N.50 3/4° W., 24.4 ft., with a healed blaze.
