- A hemlock, 16" dia., bears S.43°E., 29 lks., mkd: T25S R2W S14 BT.
- A cedar, 7" dia. bears S.56°W. 34 lks. mkd: T25S R2W S15 BT
- A cedar, 24" dia. bears N.67°W. 32 lks. mkd: T25S R2W S10 BT
