with scribe marks ¼ S24 BT visible on open blaze.
and new bearing trees
A fir, 14" dia., bears S.63°W., 7.0 ft., mkd. ¼ S25 BT.
A fir, 9" dia., bears N.6¾°W., 22.1 ft., mkd. ¼ S24 BT.
Each new bearing tree has a 2½"x ¼" magnetic nail (Mag Nail)
driven at the base right side-center.
