BTs by N. Price in 1944 -

A 23" double trunk B.Oak bears N.18 $\frac{3}{4}$ °E., 134.6 ft. with a healed single blaze.

A 19" triple trunk W.Oak bears N.43 $\frac{3}{4}$ °W., 177.5 ft. with a healed single blaze. (Rec. N.43°W.) The center of the root crown of the now triple trunk W.Oak bears N.43 $\frac{3}{4}$ °W., 180.0 ft.

New BTs- A 9" dia. I.Cedar bears N.85 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 129.3 ft. scribed "1/4 S7 CS BT".

A 11" dia. W.Oak bears N.67 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W., 62.6 ft. scribed "1/4 S12 CS BT".

Compass declination - 15° E.

Location & comments - All BTs have BT tags attached. All new BTs have double blazed faces with bearings measured to the center of the tree at the root crown and distances measured to the side and center of the root crown unless otherwise noted. Corner falls on a gentle NW slope at the N. edge of an open pasture surrounded by a mixed woodland of oak, fir and cedar.
