10" Horse Chestnut bears S.31°E., 41.6 ft. which I bark  
scribe "T25S R4W S7 BT".

20" Maple bears S.11°W., 66.7 ft. which I bark scribe  
"T25S R5W S12 BT".

5/8" x 30" Iron rod bears N.2°W., 31.1 ft. in fence line.

The corner lies 100 ft. ± east of farmhouse and all bearing  
trees are domestic shade trees. Bark scribing used to avoid  
any possible damage to these trees.
