Found - A 2½" USBLM standard brass capped iron post, by Zirpel, Corbin, & Roseberry in 1957 & accessories by Kris DeGroot in 2004 per M146-4. The monument is leaning Northwesterly towards the creek, and is horizontally stable, but it moves vertically. The flanges of the monument are visible beneath the undermined creek bank. To preserve the M146-4 position, I tie the reference monuments and compute the corner position by holding the record angle, and scaling the distances. From this position:

A ⅝" iron rod bears N.60°07'53"E., 14.995 ft
(N.60°11'02"E., 15.00 ft)

A ⅝" iron rod bears S.11°28'46"W., 34.989 ft
(S.11°31'56"W., 35.00 ft)

The BCIP bears N.10°31'42"E., 0.062 ft.
