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A 10" Fir, now 34" dia., 2 foot tall fir stump with possible blaze evidence found inside, bears N.63°W., 63.7 ft. (Rec. N.61°30'W., 63.7') 1931

A 15" Pine, now a shattered stump partially buried under rocks by excavation work, bears S.58°E., 56.0 ft. (As per rec.) 1931

A 9" B.Oak, now a 17" D.B.H. B.Oak with a fully healed double blaze, bears N.46½°E., 29.0 ft. (Rec. N.49½°E., 29.0')

New BTs- A 13" D.B.H. Pine, double blazed and scribed "¼ S17 CS BT" bears S.45°E., 69.5 ft.

A 7" D.B.H. W.Oak, double blazed and scribed "¼ S17 CS BT" bears S.4½°E., 21.7 ft.

A double trunk Madrone, double blazed and scribed "¼ S18 CS BT on the 11" D.B.H. trunk which is the southerly and larger trunk. The center of the root crown bears, N.60°W., 18.9 ft. 1" dia., iron rod, firmly set and protruding 6" from the ground (rec. 5/8" I.P.) bears South 103.1 ft. (1968 Barnes M36-55)

Monument lies at boundary of second growth forest land to the East and subdivided housing land to the West.
