Original - Elder & Gile, Contract #31 dated April, 1853

Set ¼ Sec. post, from which
 A Fir, 5" dia. bears N.20°W., 46 lks. dist.
 A Y.Oak 4" dia. bears S.34½°W., 37 lks dist.

Set a sawed post & buried a brick alongside from which
 A Fir 18" dia. bears N.35°W., 40 lks. dist. from which
 a Fir 20" dia. bears S.36°E., 50 lks. dist. The NW BT,
 the only one standing, had it's marks destroyed by fire
 several years ago, but being vigorous, I remarked same.
 I have known this tree to be an original bearing tree
 for 18 years or longer.

Found - A 5/8" iron rod, 0.8 feet East of newest barbed wire
 fence, and uncovered to 0.1' feet above ground.
 24" Doug-Fir with Burt Holt tag that calls this tree
 as the corner tree (0.0' feet to the corner).
 1946 BLM tag on same 24" Doug-Fir which calls this
 tree as the corner tree. This tree bears
 S.22°36'56"W at a distance of 10 feet from the
 iron rod.

Location (Procedures & description) -

A preliminary open ended GPS & Transit survey was conducted to
establish the position of the fences, marked corner tree, and
old stumps for original and Thiel 1900 renewal search. Our
search yielded the following position of an unrecorded 5/8"
iron rod. The iron rod lies in the remains of a very old,
approximately 60 years old, barb wire fence line that was
completely down and buried in debris. We found no conclusive
evidence to renew either the original or Thiels renewal
location. The position of the unrecorded iron rod is
N89°48'11"E and 2642, from the NWSC of S10. The unrecorded rod
also bears S89°49'38"W and 26402 feet from the NESC of S10.

New - We made 2 BT's for the found 5/8" iron rod.
 A 24" D.Fir which bears S.22°37'W., 10 ft., scribed
 "BT" in face.
 A 17" D.Fir which bears N.0°57'W., 20 ft., scribed
 "BT" in face. Tree blazed as line tree.
