Found - From a Garrett survey filed as M56-19 DCSO records, we find a 1" I.P protruding 1" from ground & firmly set bearing N.01°W., 807.5 ft. (Record N.01°06'15"W., 807.41 ft.) This survey also recorded finding the bearing trees of 1963 at record bearings & distances from the brass cap.  
We accept monument location.  
New BTs- A 26" DBH W.Oak bears S.57½°E., 53.0 ft. distant & is scribed ¼ S16 CS BT on a double blaze; This tree also has a natural scar on the NE side near the ground.  
A 30" DBH W.Oak bears S.02°W., 38.2 ft. distant & is scribed ¼ S17 CS BT on a double blaze.  
We tag the new bearing trees with DCSO BT tags.
