



TOWNSHIP 25 RANGE 06 POINT IDENTIFIER # 300540

PRIMARY CORNER DESCRIPTION 1/4 Cor. for Secs. 8 & 9

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Possible Germond found stone, 8x8x3½ & stone fragments. (Orig. size 2x8x16) bearing N.36°E., 2.0 ft. from fd. B.C. Top of stone 3" below ground.  
Orig. SW BT not found.  
Possible evidence of Orig. SE 11" Y.Oak BT found. A rotted 2 ft. tall 18" dia. Oak stump previously opened but showing no scribing bears S.39½°E., 21.1 ft. dist. at center of root crown. (Rec. S.34½°E., 19.8 ft. dist. is possible face measurement)  
Germond BT, a 40" now 4 ft. 30" dia. rotted Oak stump with a previously opened blaze, no scribing found, removed from orig. position by road work, bears S.02°E., 17.0 ft. (Rec. S.26½°W., 35 ft.)  
12" R.Fir now a 26" DBH D.Fir with a fully healed double blaze bears N.8½°E., 21.6 ft.  
8" W.Oak now a 13" DBH W.Oak with a fully healed double blaze bears N.68½°W., 60.3 ft.  
New BTs - 6" DBH W.Oak, double blaze & scribed "¼ S9 CS BT" bears S.72½°E., 13.4 ft.  
9" DBH D.Fir, double blazed & scribed "¼ S8 CS BT" bears S.55°W., 33.7 ft.  
Monument lies in N-S fence line at easterly edge of farm access road & approx. 60 ft. South from C/L of Cole Rd. #91.
