 this tree has been pushed out of position where
 it fell, but a portion of the top appears to be
 in position. From location of top & length of
 main trunk, found depression in ground which I
 believe to be the stump hole.

No trace of 8" Oak North of corner.

5/8" x 30" long iron rod with Alum. cap stamped
"B01 1998" in fence line, bears South 122.7
ft, protrudes 8" above ground.
Note - BC/IP is 100 ft. North of a ridge running
N.75°E., area around cap is open.
