No. 1 of this survey, identical with cor. No. 4 of the listing survey, which I destroy and in its place establish Cor. No. 1 of this survey as follows: Set a diorite stone, 24x12x12", 14" in the ground, over a stone marked with a cross for cor. No. 1 of this survey, marked 1 HES 229 on side facing the claim, from which A fir, 6" dia., bears N.66°15'W., 63 lks., marked X 1 HES 229 BT. A madrona, 6" dia., bears N.11°00'E., 32 lks., marked X 1 HES 229 BT. Dig pits, 24x24x12", crosswise on each course, 7 ft. and raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3½ ft. dist., within the claim.
