Cor. No. 1, identical with Cor. H/1 of list survey, a fir, 30" dia., mkd. & witnessed as described by G.A. Bonebrake, Forest Ranger, I blaze & scribe the tree 1 HES 142 on NW face, for Cor. 1, from which

A cedar, 12" dia., bears N.64°00'W., 67 lks.
A Fir, 26" dia., bears N.12°00'W., 96 lks.
Both trees blazed and scribed 1 HES 142 BT.
USLM No. 142, bears S.5°03'E., 5.23 chs.
Pit and mounds impracticable at this and all other cors.
