11" dia., Hemlock with scribing visible on a partially healed double blaze "SEC COR S32 BT" bears S.58°W., 25.7 ft. (1999 BT tag by GVN, brg & dist on tag N.54°E., 26.0 ft.)

7" dia., Hemlock with scribing visible on a partially healed double blaze "X BT" bears S.38½°E., 13.3 ft (1999 BT tag by GVN brg & dist on tag N.40°W. 13.30 ft)

11" dia., D.Fir with scribing visible on a partially healed double blaze, "28 SEC" bears N.4°E., 7.7 ft. (1999 BT tag by GVN brg & dist on tag S.2°W., 7.75 ft.)

8" dia., D.Fir with scribing visible on a partially healed double blaze "SEC COR" bears N.28°W., 42.6 ft. (1999 BT Tag by GVN brg & dist on tag S.30°E., 43 ft.)

6" now rotted remains of a hemlock bears S.52°W., 22.2 ft. orig. rec. (S.52°W., 26.4 ft.)
