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From the newly established ¼ cor. of secs. 15 & 22, the cor. established by Gibb as the ¼ cor. on S bdy of sec. 15 bears S.55°03'E, m 24,55 chs.

I destroy the cors. which I established in 1916 as the ¼ cor. on the S bdy. of sec. 15 & the ¼ cor. on N bdy. of sec. 22; also marks on BTs.

BLM dependent resurvey by Irving Zirpel, Jr. & Wm. Glenn, Cadastral Surveyors, Group No. 404, surveyed May/Oct. 1959 - (DCSO Vol. 30 Page(s) 12728-9)

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The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 15 & 22, monumented with an iron post 1" dia., 4" above ground, firmly set, in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top set by Mensch in 1918, with brass cap (properly) mkd.
