A DCSO disk on an I.P. stamped "County Surveyors Office T26S R3W W.C. ¼ S9 S10 35 ft. S. to cor. 1966" bears North, 33.95 ft. (Rec. North 35.0 ft.)

New - A 4" square metal post with a black satellite dish attached bears N.82½°E., 20.0 ft.

10" D.Fir with a double well healed blaze that faces NE, bears N.9½°W., 27.7 ft. (BT per Tracy scribed to wit. cor.)

19" D.Fir with a double well healed blaze that faces westerly bears N.36½°E., 37.6 ft. (BT per Tracy scribed to Wit. Cor.)

Corner lies on steep rock bluff on the North bank of the North Umpqua River in back yard of house at 22127 N. Umpqua Highway. New BTs are BTs used for Wit. Cor. These are used instead of scribing new trees to protect scenic value of yard.

Found - 1966 DCSO disk on an I.P. protruding 10" above ground. Evidence of a mound of stone present around I.P.

8" now 10" D.Fir with a well healed double blaze bears S.30½°W., 7.7 ft. (Rec. S.34°W., 8.4' dist. is to center of trunk)

A U.S. GLO disk stamped "T26S R3W ¼ S9 S10 1972" bears South 33.95 ft. (Rec. South 35.0 ft. per Tracy and 1972 resurvey)

New - SE foundation corner of main house bears N.35°E., 6.1 ft.

Witness Corner lies under wood deck of house at 22127 N. Umpqua Hwy. on top of bluff on North bank of the N. Umpqua Highway.
