To Angle Point #5, Set an Iron Post 3 ft. long 1" dia., 27" in the ground, for Angle Point #5, Power Reserve, with brass cap marked:

from which

A Fir 16" dia., bears N.27°W., 105 lks. dist. mkd.
AP 5 PR BT.

Found - GLO brass cap 1924, firmly set and properly marked.
16" D.Fir now 20" N.27°W., 69.3 ft. Shows scar.

This corner lies S.45°E., 29.0 ft. from center line road and 42.0 ft. south from center line road.
