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Set post cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, from which  
A Fir 8" dia. bears S.16°E., 278 lks. dist.  
A Pine 10" dia. bears S.35°W., 110 lks. dist.  
A Pine 12" dia. bears N.20°E., 45 lks. dist.  
A Pine 10" dia. bears N.40°W., 92 lks. dist.

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Bureau of Land Management Dependent Resurvey - Zirpel, Corbin  
and Roseberry - Special Instructions dated July 8, 1957 and  
July 15, 1958 (DCSO records, Volume 29 Page 12259-60)

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Beginning at the point for the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36,  
on S. bdy. of the Tp., at proportionate distance, there is no  
remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28" long, 2½" dia. 26" in the ground, and in  
a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, with brass cap mkd:

A Madrone 7" dia. bears N.38°45'W., 86 lks. dist. marked

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Found - B.L.M. Brass cap on a 2" iron pipe pulled out of  
ground by recent tractor activity. We reset corner  
back in original hole with cap at ground level in mound  
of stones and metal fence post 1 ft. north.

Found BT's -

17" Madrone stump bears N.38°50'W., 56.7 ft. (rec.  
N.38°45'W 56.76 ft. no marks visible

15" Oak stump bears N.79°30'E., 104.3 ft.

(rec.N.79°15'E., 104.28 ft.) vis. scar and B.L.M. tag.

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TOWNSHIP 26 RANGE 04 POINT IDENTIFIER # 600700

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23" Alder bears S.60°15'E., 264.0 ft. (rec. S.60°15'E.,  
264.66 ft.) visible well healed scar, and tag tree.  
6" Madrone of record - no trace.  
New Accessory - Railroad tie fence post bears S.25°30'E.,  
101.83 ft. I tag post.  
Note - Corner lies on an east facing slope approximately 100  
ft. northwest of corral and road on flat bottom ground.
