of Main line track on E.W. Centerline of Section 7.

Found - 1½" pipe set in East R/W line of RR for reference

Crossing E. side of tracks, bears S.43°W., 14.2 ft.

Power Pole, Copco B 10265, bears S.65°E., 14.8 ft.
