Found - W.Oak now 16" dia. S.19°W., 28.4 ft., chopped open & found good scribing "S 31", this tree has been opened approx. 50 yrs. ago & rehealed over old face.
W.Oak now 13" dia., N.9°E., 28.4 ft., this tree had also been opened approx. 50 yrs. ago, did not reopen.
W.Oak now 18" dia., N.25°W., 37.0 t. (instead of 38.3 ft) faint old scars visible, did not open.
W.Oak, not B.Oak, now 16" dia., S.29°E., 37.6 ft. shows good scars, possibly opened previously, dis not reopen.
