Orig. now 24" B.Oak S.9°E., 26.4 ft. shows good  
scar. I do not open.  
New BT - 12" W.Oak bears N.18°E., 30.3 ft. scribed MC S23  
CS BT.

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Found - ½" Iron pipe set in concrete.  
Orig. B.Oak now 24" S.9°E., 26.4 ft. Tree dead and  
down, shows good scar, did not open.  
12" orig. W.Oak now 31" N.16½°W., 38.2 ft. still  
alive & standing.  
12" W.Oak N.18°E., 30.3 ft. still alive & standing,  
scribing still visible. (1958 BT).  
New BT - 17" W.Oak S.40°E., 31.5 ft. mkd. MC S26 CS BT.
