<p>Original - Addison R. Flint, Contract #31 dated April, 1854 ----- Set post a SE Cor. C 62 on line between Secs. 5 & 6, from which: A B.Oak 25" dia. bears N.87°W., 240 lks. Raised mound with trench as per instructions.</p>
<p>Frank Cain, Co. Surveyor - Dec. 8, 1914 - Vol. 2 Pg. 267 ----- Sandstone 4" x 4" x 20" marked X 62, from which A B.Oak 20" marked C.S. C.62 T26S R6W B.T. bears N.14°E., 164 lks.</p>
<p>Milo E. Godfrey - Deputy Co. Surveyor - Vernon R. Trace; Jack Barnett - August 1964 - C.S. File 52/87-90 ----- Found - Rock (4" x 4" top) with good "X" on top, top flush with level of ground. 34" B.Oak, very plain scar visible in good condition bearing N.14°E., 108 ft. from corner. New BT - 8" Madrone S.33°W., 80.5 ft. mkd. S.E. DLC 62 CSBT.</p>

<p>Douglas Co. Surveyors Office - Randall W. Smith, Deputy - Stephen J. Flause - 7/19/2000 - C.S. File 66/16-26 ----- Found - Firmly set stone top measures 4"x4" with a chiseled "X" flush with ground (1914) 20" now 41" dia., B.Oak with a fully healed single blaze, bears N.14°E., 108.2 ft. (1914) 8" now 10" dia., 1 ft. high Madrone stump with a rotted blaze, bears S.33°W., 80.5 ft. (1964) New - 31" dia., D.Fir single blazed & scribed "SE DLC 62 CS BT" bears S.48½°E., 126.0 ft. From stump of 1964 BT a triple trunked Madrone now grows, bark scribe easterly 6" trunk "CS SE DLC 62 BT" root crown bears S.33°W., 80.5 ft. 8" dia., D.Fir double blazed & scribed "SE DLC 62 CS BT" bears S.79°W., 27.0 ft. Set a metal wit. post & sign east 1 ft. of corner.</p>
